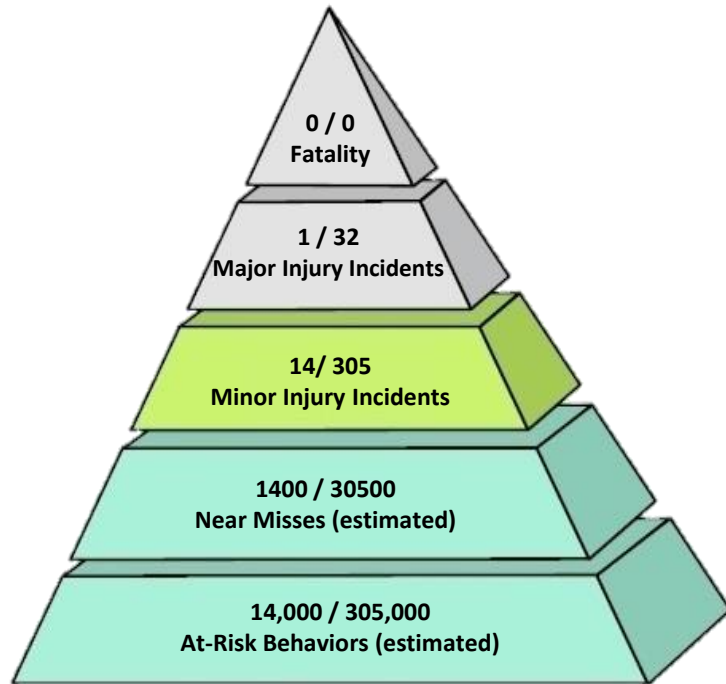


Safe Scouting Weekly Report – Week 30

Weekly Incident Report: Three Scouts were left to tend a campfire; 1 Scout used some nearby accelerant on the fire causing it to burn out of control. Two of the youth attempted to douse the flames with water which made the situation worse and spread the fire to their nearby coats which lit up in flames. Luckily no major injuries occurred.

Safe Scouting's Tip for Success: Fire safety! Ensure that there is always proper supervision when having a campfire. In this incident the Scouters had left the campfire area to conduct other activities leaving the three youth by themselves. It is also highly recommended that accelerants not be used on lit fires. If an accelerant is needed, it should be used and then stored in a safe area before lighting the fire.
