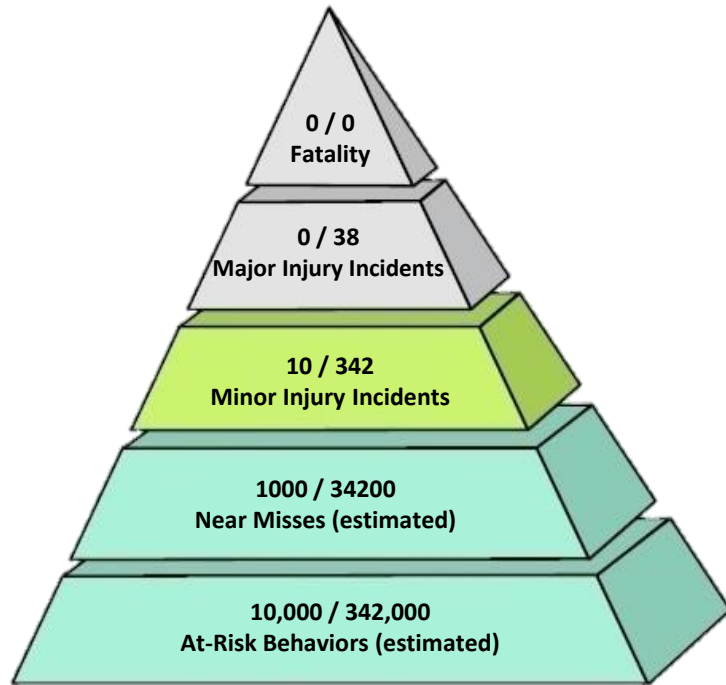


Safe Scouting Weekly Report – Week 34

Weekly Incident Report: A Cub Scout was cooking hot dogs over a fire at camp. When he went to stand up, he placed his hand on the fire ring resulting in burns across his fingers. A Scouter placed the youth's hand under cool running water for 5 minutes and he was able to return to activity. The youth's parents were immediately notified of the incident.

Safe Scouting's Tip for Success: Campfires are an important part of the camp experience, but there are risks. As this incident demonstrates, it only takes a moment of inattentiveness for potential injury to happen. Use safety talks to ensure youth are cautious around the fire and to discuss campfire safety with them.
