

S.L.S. BEAVER BUGGY RULES 2019

- a) Maximum weight for Beaver Buggy is to be 100 gm.
- b) The only weights that are allowed are Canadian Beaver nickels. These weights are to be glued to the top of the Beaver Buggy base.
- c) The registration number is to be located at the top rear of the Beaver Buggy base. Only the Registration number is to be used on the Beaver Buggy, no other numbers are to be shown.
- d) Light oil or graphite powder may be used as lubricants for the wheels and axels. Each racer will be able to lubricate their vehicle once before the runoffs and once before the finals. HOWEVER, No excess lubricant is permitted.
 - i) Each Beaver Buggy will be assessed for excess lubricant by the officials at registration and the officials have sole responsibility for this judgement. If a Beaver Buggy is judged to have excess lubricant it will not be registered and the Beaver Buggy will have to be cleaned to the officials satisfaction before it can be registered.
- e) Identification:

All entrants must have the following information in ink on the unpainted bottom of the Beaver Buggy.

 - i) Name
 - ii) Age (as of Dec 31)
 - iii) Colony and Area
 - iv) Current Year 2018/2019
- f) Only one Beaver Buggy may be entered per Beaver and may not be a previous years' Beaver Buggy.
- g) **If glitter is used, it MUST be sealed with a clear finish.**
- h) Once the Beaver-buggy has been inspected and approved and the races have started, there will be NO adjustments or lubrication allowed unless damage has occurred while racing.

The cost for registration for the 2019 Scouting year is \$7.00 per Buggy.
