CAMPSITES

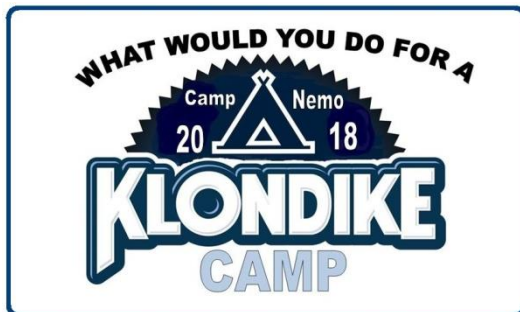
The following camping areas are reserved for Klondike:

FYI'S OF CAMP
