# RSVP Camp Rules

**Please Note:** Camp Opemikon is a nut-free camp. Do not bring any products that contain nuts on the property.

**All tabins require a reservation**, and are available on a first-come-first-served basis. Tabins will be assigned in the order that paid registration has been received, pending any medical requirements and/or travel distance. **Only one tabin is allowed per group. Absolutely NO cooking or eating in tabins.**

1. All the standard Scouts Canada rules apply. Each group is responsible for their paper work forms. NO DRUGS OR ALCOHOL IS PERMITTED!! A shell emergency plan is available at

2. We allow symbols that are not offensive in their modern context. We reserve the right to ban symbols that we deem inappropriate.

3. The weekend agenda will continue rain or shine. Please be prepared for the weather. Accommodation for emergency purposes are limited. Those requiring assistance should report to Clements Lodge.

**4. Groups will not be permitted on Camp property until after 4:30pm. Any groups arriving before that time will be asked to leave site, and return at 4:30pm.**

5. Camp curfew is 11:00pm- you are required to stay within your camping areas and respect your neighbours. This will be enforced!

6. All RSVP participants are REQUIRED to be active members of their organization. All groups are required to have a member sign for their group upon registration and again upon departure in Clements Lodge. **All groups are required to present medical forms for ALL participants—including scouters and guiders—which will be returned at the end of the camp.**

**Please submit the medical forms collectively in a suitable folder or envelope, marked with the group name and contact person.**

7. All groups must come self-contained; the \$35 participant fee and \$10 Scouter fee **does not** cover the cost of food. Potable water will be available at certain locations. We have a limited amount of space for parking so please limit the amount of vehicles that you bring to camp.

8. Please wear clothing appropriate for scouting activities and camping, and full uniforms for opening and closing of camp.

**Parking:** Upon arrival each vehicle will be:

1. Provided a parking pass that must be displayed on the driver's side of the dashboard at all times,  
*and*

2. Given mandatory assistance when unloading gear and bringing it to their site in the unloading/drop off area. Each vehicle will be given a time limit of 10 minutes in the drop off area to ensure an efficient flow of traffic.

3. **There is absolutely no parking, stopping or loading/unloading vehicles on the access road by Clements field**

**PLEASE NOTE: The speed limit on Opemikon property is 10 kph. and will be strictly enforced.**

**Registration:** Canadian Registration opens on Monday November 5th, American Registration opens on Monday November 12<sup>th</sup>. Early Registration closes on Friday January 18th, & Final Registration closes on Friday April 19<sup>th</sup> **NO EXCEPTIONS**

**Refund Policy:** Refunds will be available until **Monday April 1st, 2019** without question

**Departure:**

All campsites must be inspected prior to groups departure. Upon successful completion, you will receive your documents and crests from the site Inspector.
