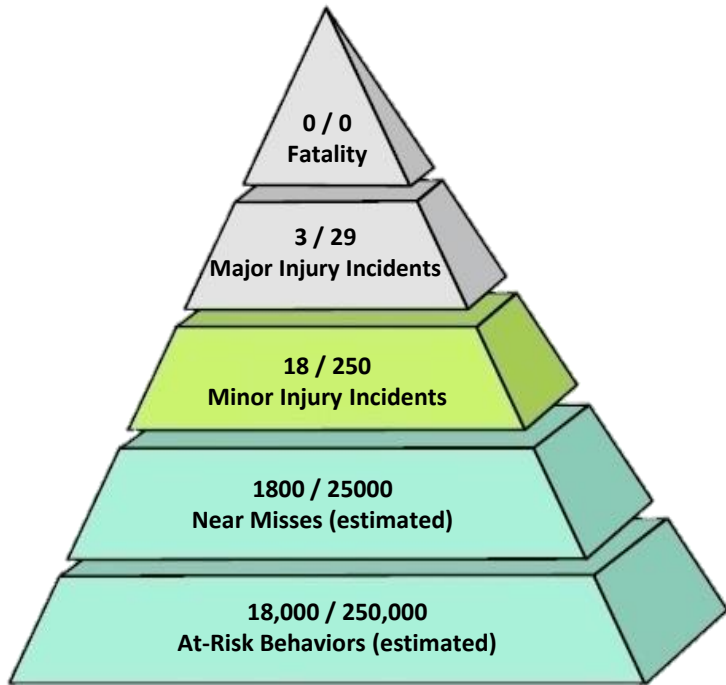


# Safe Scouting Weekly Report – Week 27

**Weekly Incident Report:** While constructing a Beaver Buggy, a Beaver Scout was burned by hot glue on the back of his hand.

**Safe Scouting's Tip for Success:** Like all tools, safety must be considered when using a hot-glue gun and discussed with the youth prior to the activity. Burns from using a hot-glue gun are common, either from mishandling the equipment or from distraction. Although the burns are typically minor, they can be completely mitigated by the use of protective gloves and long sleeves. It is also important to have a stand or aluminum cup to rest the glue-gun in when it is not being used. Always remember to unplug the glue gun when you are finished using it.
