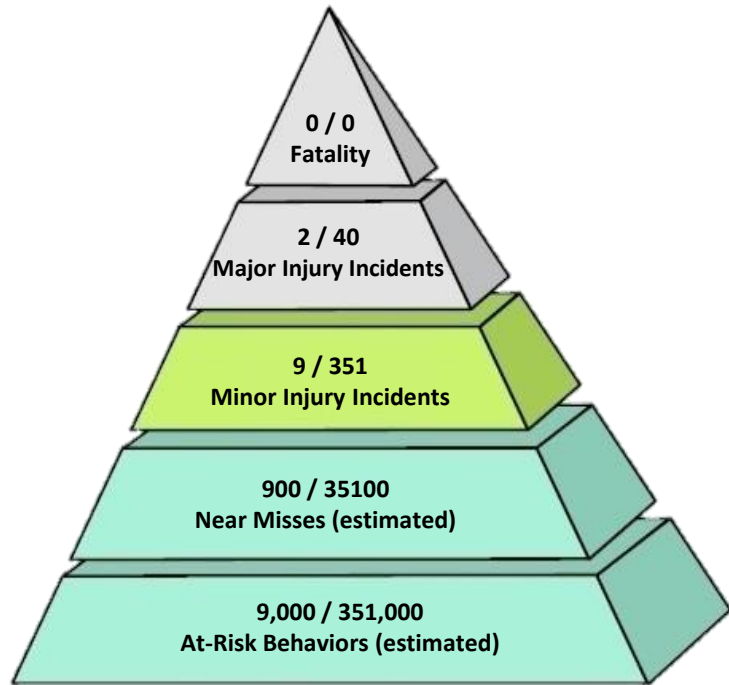


Safe Scouting Weekly Report – Week 35

Weekly Incident Report: During free time at a weekend camp, a Beaver Scout stepped on a rusty nail, puncturing the sole of his foot. The wound was cleaned and bandaged by a First Aider. Medical information on file did not indicate if the youth's tetanus vaccination was up to date, but his parents confirmed that it was.

Safe Scouting's Tip for Success: Many incidents occur during free-time. Trips, falls, cuts, and collisions between youth are frequently reported. Free-time, like any Scouting activity, needs to include a component of safety. Using plan-do-review, youth can identify potential hazards, discuss safe boundaries and safe conduct. Scouters are aware that any cut or wound must be thoroughly cleaned to prevent infection and have a first aid kit that is easily accessible at all times.
