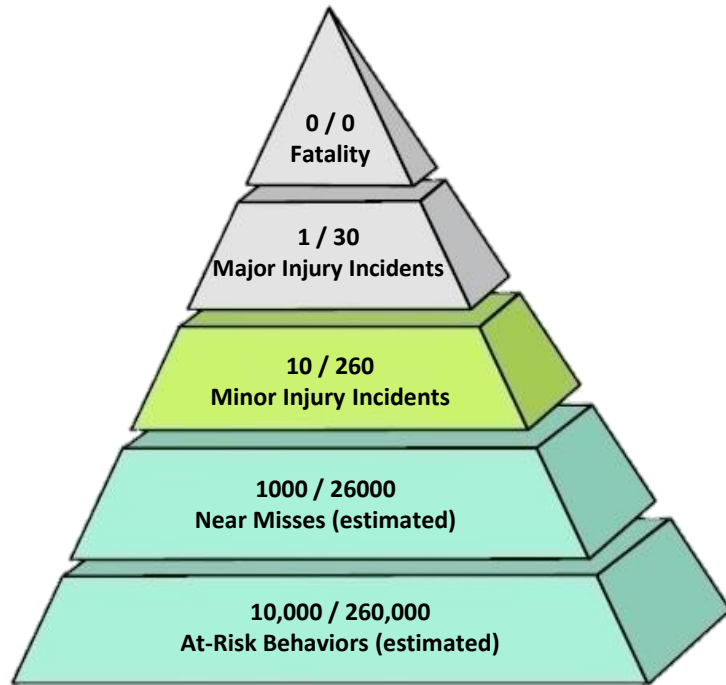


# Safe Scouting Weekly Report – Week 28

**Weekly Incident Report:** A Beaver youth was running in the Colony meeting space during a ‘free time’ period. The youth ended up running into an unpadding column in the middle of the meeting area and suffered a head injury. The Beaver was taken to the hospital for concussion assessment but no concussion was diagnosed.

**Safe Scouting’s Tip for Success:** Know your meeting area! The vast majority of injuries that are reported take place in the regular meeting hall. Your regular meeting area represents the space in which the majority of your Scouting will take place and has the most exposure to a potential injury. Use the [Meeting Space Risk Assessment checklist](#) to help identify risks and prevent incidents. Doing a meeting safety inspection, before each meeting starts is a great way to involve the youth as well.
