Christmas gifts and stocking-stuffer ideas for all of the Scouters in your family

Wide Mouth Nalgene bottle: \$10-12

Wide mouth can accept ice cubes in summer and can double as a hot water bottle for sleeping

Pocket Knife: \$10-15

With locking blade

1st Aid Kit: \$8-15

Small enough to fit in a daypack or on one of the straps

Compass: \$15-20

Orienteering style with a base plate

Spork: \$3-4

E.g. "Light my fire"

Bottle Holder: \$8-15

This is a pocket or insulated cozy

Headlamp: \$12-25

Much easier than a flashlight when you need to "go"

2 C Measuring Cup (plastic): \$1-2

Makes a great bowl or cup for winter camps.

Heavy Duty Silver blanket: \$15-20

Great as a ground sheet

More expensive gift ideas: Cook set, Single burner stove, Good sleeping bag, Backpack, Sleeping pad

Updated Child and Youth Safety Information



Returning volunteers must have a complete Wood Badge 1 training in their Primary Role.

While some volunteers may have multiple roles in the organization outside of their one section leadership role, the Training and Screening requirements relate to an individual's primary role as defined in their profile on myscouts.ca

As an example, if a Cub Scout Leader with Colony Wood Badge 1 was registered last year as a Cub Scout Leader, and is returning as a Cub Scout Leader, they must complete the Wood Badge 1 for Pack by December 31 to be considered compliant.

New volunteers have until August 31, 2013 to complete the Wood Badge 1 certification relevant to their Primary Role.

Training can be undertaken through a Scouter's local Council, or through eLearning on myscouts.ca. An eLearning tutorial and detailed yet simple instructions are posted on the Training-landing page in myscouts.ca
